Field of Play Incidents

Once again it was stated that all on the field of play incidents and the performance of the match day referee
Must be reported to their respective Football Association as under FA rules leagues are not allowed to make
judgments

If teams feel that the match day referee marks are below 50 they must send a letter into the league
explaining why failure will result in league fines being issued,

Respect and Code of Conduct

Spectator barriers must be used per league rules

***All member clubs must adhere to the Respect code of conduct. Respect barriers and designated
spectator areas must be in place for every fixture where fixed post & rail facilities are not in
place. Any club failing to erect Respect barriers during a scheduled fixture shall be?
Automatically fined the fixed sum of £25.00. FAILURE TO ERECT RESPECT BARRIERS WILL NOT
BE SUFFICIENT REASON TO POSTPONE A FIXTURE.***

The FA code of Conduct as Issued to all clubs and displayed on the Leagues web site
Must be practised by all Clubs/Teams/Managers/Captains/Players/Coaches/ and Spectators
Failure will result in hefty fines being issued by The Football Association/Counties

All the above are mandatory instructions from the Football Association

As previously remarked team sheet administration needed to be improved
The following sections must be completed or league fines will be issued

Once fixtures have been scheduled by the league
managers are not allowed to change them or re arrange them. If this happens there will be league fines
issued for non fulfilment of fixtures

The new under 11s 7 x 7
Players have to have reached the age of nine years and be under 11 as at 31/08/2010
Normal small sided rules apply to all games

They will play 25mins each way

The under 10s playing time has been reduced to 20 mins each way

There will be two cup competitions for the under 10s & 11s Open Cup and League Shield

The complete fixture dates were distributed to all clubs
These are the dates that league fixtures will be scheduled all teams must be available for fixtures should one
be scheduled
The league only have to give 5 days' notice to teams for rearranged fixtures

Substitution Rules

Once again the secretary explained the substitution rules they have not changed from last season
Also they are clearly defined in the league rules they are

Under 10s & Under 11s in the main league
Up to a maximum of 14 named player on a roll on roll off substitutions
All players listed on the team sheet must take some part in the game
Failure to comply will result in league fines being issued

Main League

Can have a match day playing squad of 16 players and can be used on a roll on roll off basis throughout the
game.

Open Age

Can have a match day playing squad of 14 players and can be used on a roll on roll off basis throughout the game.

Team Sheets

Main league teams

Under10s.11.12.13.14.15.16.

Must use the team sheet pads they have two pages top copy and blue copy

The blue copy is kept in the book and the top copy is sent to the League Secretary per league rules

These pads are available from the main officers of the league at a cost of £3:00 per pad

Under 17 & Under 18s to continue to use the one sheet system they can be down loaded from the leagues web site.

Open Age

Continue to use the one sheet system

Can be down loaded from the leagues web site

It was stated that teams can only enter outside cup competitions that are run by their affiliated Football association or The football association

If you are thinking of going on a football Tournament you first must get permission from the league secretary

Permission will normally be given

This only applies till the end of December

After this there will be no permission given and should teams not be able to play their league fixture

Heavy fines will be issued

John gave a full and concise report to the meeting outlining the procedure for the season

And what is expected from team

Would all teams please visit the fixtures section on the leagues website every week as the league only have to give 5 days' notice of rearranged fixtures,

John also reminded the meeting that if mid week fixtures are required they are mandatory and must be played.

MANAGER'S RESPONSIBILITIES

Confirm match as early as possible (preferably on a Sunday) – don't forget to colours – 14 day notice to league if you wish to change kick off time.

If there is likely to be a problem with pitch let opponents know asap and switch venues if available.

On Match Day if game is off notify in the same way as normal result notification (text or e-mail) DO NOT TELEPHONE ME TO TELL ME.

Someone should be at ground at least an hour before kick off to greet visitors.

If not allowed to warm up on pitch then an adequate area should be made available at least 30 mins before ko.

The Referee should be neutral, if the ref has ANY link to the club this must be explained to opponents beforehand (there really is no need for this to be the case)

If there is no qualified referee the job MUST be offered to the away side.

After game pay the ref asap as he/she may have another game to go to.

Fill in team sheet – in particular goals corers and referee marks and SEND TO LES NOT JOHN.

Report result (with goals scorers) ASAP after the final whistle and no later than midnight on Saturday.

If anyone had any queries would they see him after the meeting?
